PREFACE

In compiling this price list we have endeavored to condense the number of stamps by ignoring the different controllers' surcharges as separate varieties, and, as far as the extensive issues of the circular stamps of California are concerned, the various shades from carmine to vermilion have been placed under one color. Very thin and medium papers are also listed as one. We believe that the multiplying of varieties, through the cataloging of the minor ones mentioned above, in lists heretofore published, has discouraged the collection of this class of stamps in the past. For those who enjoy exploring a comparatively unknown field, the collecting of State revenue stamps offers an exceptionally interesting study. This list has been compiled from official documents and with the help of leading specialists, yet it is probable that the more general study of these stamps will eliminate some varieties and add others. Owing to the limited territory in which State revenues were used, the fact that many became obsolete forty years ago, and also that the manner of their use caused the majority of them to be destroyed, they are much scarcer than the average collector realizes, hence the prices given herein should be considered as net.
