Effective August 11, 1970 all tobacco products began being taxed via the reporting method, thus the discontinuance of a variety of tax stamps. At the present time, we inventory and sell only four (4) different stamps which are the decal and fuson cigarette stamps in 13¢ denomination and the 15¢ and 45¢ malt extract paper stamps. The use of meter indicia is permitted to be used for cigarette stamping.
