Gentlemen:

We have examined the balance sheet of the Liquor Control Division of the Bureau of Rovenue as of June 30, 1958 and the related statements of receipts and disbursements for the year then ended. Our examination was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and rules and regulations of the State Auditor and accordingly included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

#### COMMENTS

The structure of the Liquor Control Division is outlined by Chapter 46 of the 1953 compilation of the Laws of New Mexico authorizing the Commissioner to appoint a director and deputies and employees. The rest of the structure is within the discretion of the Commissioner and Director. The powers and duties of the division provide:

- 1. For issuance of licenses and collection of fees
- 2. For suspension or revocation of licenses by director
- 3. For excise stamps to be printed and sold by Bureau
- 4. For administration of trade practices by the director

Balance Sheet - Exhibit "A":

The financial position of the Liquor Control Division at June 30, 1958, as reflected by the balance sheet of this report is subject to the following comments:

Cash on Deposit - State Treasurer - \$72,652.75:

Cash on deposit with the State Treasurer was reconciled to the Department of Finance and Administration's records and Department's books. Cash is composed of the following balances:

Accounts Receivable - \$205.56:

Debit vouchers were issued on the above account to the respective wholesalers and collections have been made subsequent to June 30, 1958.

Due to Receipts Fund - \$127.00:

This represents applications for transfers, special permits and a salesmans license approved and issued prior to June 30, 1958, but allocation to the Receipts Fund had not been made as of June 30, 1958.

Stamp Inventory - \$40,519.67:

The stamp inventory at June 30, 1958 priced at cost (Last In-First Out) based on a physical count by us at June 30, 1958, is shown on Schedule "A-4" on this report.

The increase of 5% in gross receipts is mostly attributed to the Albuquerque Office as shown on Schedule "B-1".

In the Twenty Third Legislature, New Mexico Laws of 1957, Chapter 21 states that all amounts remaining in the Liquor Control Receipts Fund on the last day of each month, shall by the State Treasurer, be transferred to the State General Fund.

Stamp Sales - \$1,991,947.59:

Stamp sales for the year ended June 30, 1958 show an increase of \$110,294.64 over the stamp sales for the year ended June 30, 1957 or 6%.
