AN INDIANA MISCELLANY

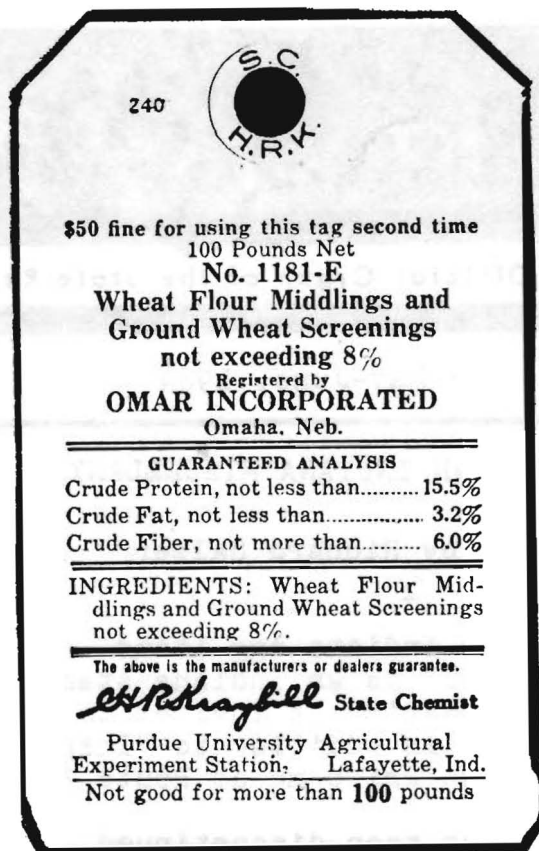

Pictured below are two Indiana egg items. It is not certain if the "Government Graded and Dated" is an Indiana stamp or a federal one used in Indiana. Anyone with information is invited to let me know. The other item presumably has numbers in addition to "Inspector 13" Anyone with specimens with other numbers can write me at Route 3, Box 791, Knox, IN 46534.

Indiana Egg stamps have been discontinued. The last series used was numbered 175 and all stamps were destroyed. These stamps were no longer required after January 1, 1982.

FISHERMAN INSTRUCTIONS

1. IMMEDIATELY upon catching legal salmon including "JACKS" in fresh or marine waters, REMOVE ONE PUNCH from the PUNCH CARD, enter the MONTH and DAY, the MARINE AREA CODE or STREAM NAME, and CATCH TYPE. See reverse side for area codes.

NOTE: IT IS UNLAWFUL TO FAIL TO VALIDATE YOUR CATCH ACCORDING TO THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

2. When you are finished fishing for the year, or by January 31, 1984, detach the PUNCH CARD from the VALIDATION STUB, and mail the PUNCH CARD to the Department of Fisheries.

NOTE: IT IS UNLAWFUL TO FAIL TO RETURN THE PUNCH CARD TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES BY JAN. 31, 1984

3. Fisherman will not be re-imburSED for lost, missing, or mutilated validation stamps.
4. Place any additional one - or three - day validation stamp(s) over previously expired stamp(s).



ARKANSAS DECAL: The Arkansas cigarette tax rate went from 5¢ to 6¢ per pack in 1951 and Hubbard # C68 was overprinted in blue "6c". Sometime later a 6¢ paper stamp was issued. This is turquoise. The stamp was apparently issued in long coils on self-adhesive paper. It bears one large hole at top and bottom.

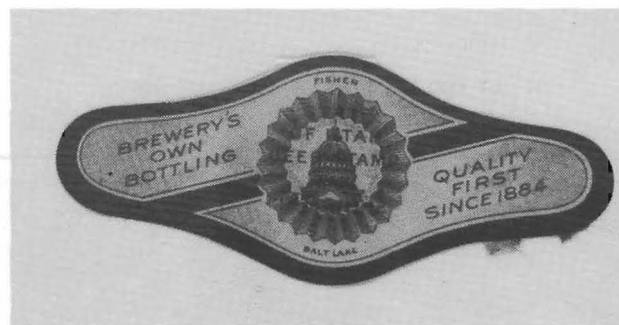
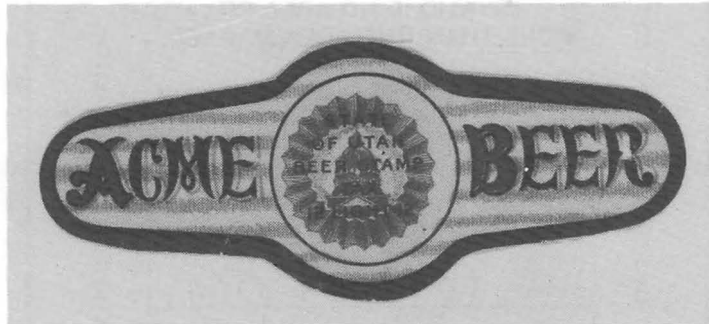


MORE ON UTAH BEER PRIVATE DIES

The stamp imprint on the "Brewery's Own Bottling" Label in red and the lettering blue on a light blue background.

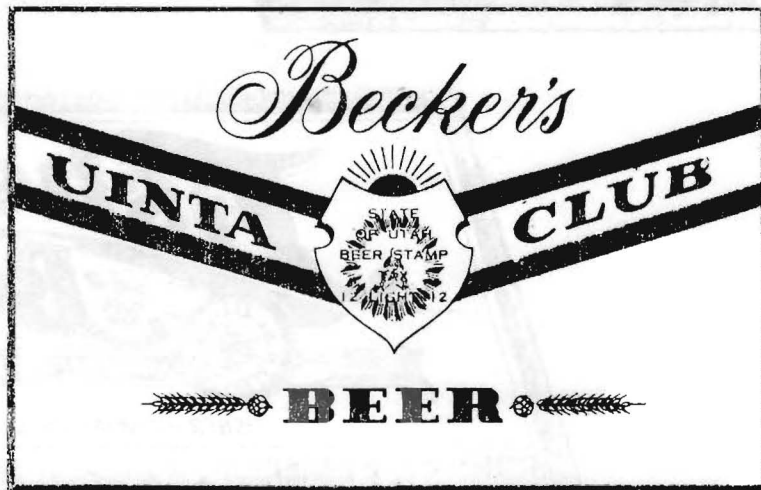


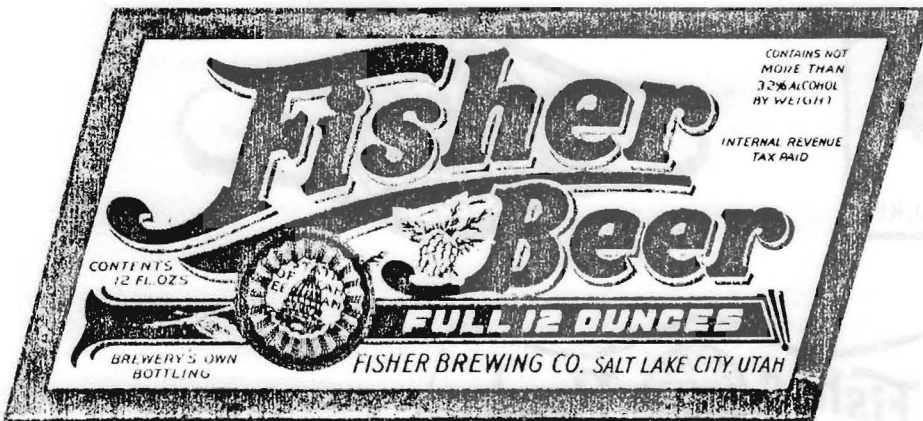
AND MORE ON UTAH BEER PRIVATE DIES

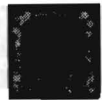

Indiana: Heat transfer decal, purple with dark yellow state map in center, red safety.



Florida: Heat transfer decal, black on yellow. Previously reported in black on blue.



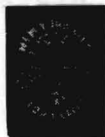
Colorado; Current heat transfer decal is gold and black with red safety.



Illinois: Yet more decals, all three illustrated are heat transfer types with red safety. The tiny one is black on pink. The larger one inscribed "ILLINOIS" at the top is black on white with a pink border. The final large one is also black on white with a coral border.



New York City: Illustrated are two older city decals. The oval decal is black and yellow. The square one is black on olive green. The inscription reads "CITY/NEW YORK/RELIEF". A 1¢ black on red value with this design also exists.
