Indiana Egg stamps have been discontinued. The last series used was numbered 175 and all stamps were destroyed. These stamps were no longer required after January 1, 1982.
















1983 SPORT SALMON

1. IMMEDIATELY upon catching legal salmon including "JACKS" in fresh or marine waters. REMOVE ONE PUNCH from the PUNCH CARD, enter the MONTH and DAY, the MARINE AREA CODE or STRLAM NAME, and CATCH TYPE, See reverse side for area codes.



The license is inscribed in black on orange paper, however the front of the license is inscribed in green and red with a red serial number.

This license is a 1982 hunting and Fishing license with Archery stamp and Upland Game Bird stamp attached. The stamp is inscribed in black with multicolored birds and red serial number. The license is on pink paper and inscribed as the other license.

ARKANSAS DECAL: The Arkansas cigarette tax rate went from 5¢ to 6¢ per pack in 1951 and Hubbard # C68 was overprinted in blue "6c". Sometime later a 6¢ paper stamp was issued. This is turquoise. The stamp was apparently issued in long coils on self-adhesive paper. It bears one large hole at top and bottom.

My request for information on these in the November-December, 1983 NEWSLETTER brought several replies. There are, it turns out, dozens of different types. Ron Lesher listed the brewers that used labels in his "Stateside-8" in the March, 1981 issue of the American Revenuer (p. 60). As Lesher pointed out, these labels are extremely colorful.

Illustrated here are two smaller ones from the collection of Dr. William Halliday. Both have a gold border. The Acme Beer label has the stamp imprint in orange-red on a reddish background. The "A" and "B" in "ACME BEER" are red, the other letters are black with faint blue outline. The stamp imprint on the "Brewery's Own Bottling" Label in red and the lettering blue on a light blue background.







AND MORE ON UTAH BEER PRIVATE DIES























Illinois: Yet more decals, all three illustrated are heat transfer types withred safety. The tiny one is black on pink. The larger one inscribed "ILLINOIS" at the top is black on white with a pink border. The final large one is also black on white with a coral border.







New York City: Illustrated are two older city decals. The oval decal is black and yellow. The square one is black on olive green. The inscription reads "CITY/NEW YORK/.


