## **Darling Design Selected For SRS Logo**

The new SRS logo, illustrated here, was unveiled at the society's annual meeting held October 1 at the 1994 Philadelphia National Stamp Exposition in King of Prussia, Pa.

The logo will be used on the SRN banner beginning with the first quarter 1995 issue and with future SRS publications and promotions.

Designed by Katherine Darling, president of the Charlotte, N.C. based Darling Design and Illustration, the logo was selected by the SRS membership from among three finalists depicted in the January-February 1994 SRN. Darling, who found out about the contest from her SRS member father, received a \$100 cash prize for her winning entry.

Darling started her design, entry number one in the contest, by borrowing a set of



stamp tongs from her father along with a copy of the contest guidelines and going to work. She used a circular shape for the logo and used a traditional serif typestyle for the wording "State Revenue Society, EST. 1955" in an outer band.

Darling added the United States map,

including Alaska and Hawaii to symbolize the society's state focus. As a representation of fiscal philately, she designed tongs and a magnifying glass for the foreground and tilted them slightly to provide perspective and dimension to the logo. She held the elements in the center of the circle together by adding the outline of a perforated stamp. For the requirement of research and scholarship, she used the "lamp of knowledge" for the symbolism.

Besides logos, Darling's firm handles a variety of projects, including brochures, catalogs, computer graphics and courtroom sketching. Before starting her own business in 1994, Darling was art director for the NBC affiliate in Charlotte. There she handled television set design, animation, news graphics and promotions.

She resides in Charlotte with her husband and four year old daughter.

## **SRS Mail Auction Rules**

1. State Revenue Society Mail Auction #4 closes May 13, 1995. Bids received after that date will not be considered.

2. Only SRS members in good standing are eligible to participate in the auction.

3. All lots are sold to the highest bidder at one bidding interval over the second highest bid. Bidding is done in the following intervals:

\$1-\$10	\$0.25
\$10-\$29	\$1.00
\$30-\$74	\$2.00
\$75-\$195	\$5.00
\$200 and over	\$10.00

On identical bids, the earliest postmark will win. If only one bid on a lot is received it will be sold at the amount bid or the catalog or estimated value, whichever is lower. Bids received in increments other than those above will be adjusted downward. Buy bids or bids under \$1 will not be accepted.

4. All auction prices are estimates unless catalog value (CV) is listed.

5. The auction manager reserves the right to withdraw any lot prior to the sale and to reject any bid believed not to have been made in good faith or that is unrealistic or not commensurate with the value of the offering. 6. Terms of sale are cash or check in US funds. Make checks payable to the SRS. Successful bidders will be notified of lots purchased and payment must be received before lots are sent. Bidders who do not remit promptly may have their auction privileges revoked.

7. Bids must be submitted on the bid sheet accompanying the auction. Reproductions of the bid sheet are acceptable. No buyers premium will be added to the sales price. The SRS is not responsible for bidder errors or omissions. Check your bid sheets carefully before mailing them in.

8. Postage, handling and insurance will be billed to the buyer, \$2 minimum.

9. Claims for errors in description must be made within three days of receipt of lots. Claims made after that time will not be considered. Lots described as collections. mixtures, "As Is", etc. are not returnable, nor are photographed lots. Lots described as defective or having faults cannot be returned because of such defects or faults.

10. The placing of a bid shall constitute full acceptance of these terms of sale. Prices realized will be published as soon as possible after the sale.


