to the edge of the mount an air space can be left which might be desirable.

To prevent wrinkles, iron from center of stamp to edge of mount, using just point of iron. There is some tendency for these mounts to curl. If you don't mind the bulk, a heavier mounting paper, such as a piece of filing card, solves the problem. Pressing the mount on the back also helps.

For the economy minded, a piece of cigarette wrapper or anything similar works as well as acetate. For laminating, I use the film made for Thermo-fax copying machine. This only costs 5¢ or 6¢ for 8½ x 11 sheets. No doubt many variations are possible.

Not very fancy, but it is simple, cheap, and makes a durable mount so one can handle these stamps."

We have also seen decals mounted on a heavy paper or card with a piece of transparent scotch tape over them. This we do not recommend as the gum on the tape discolors in time to a yellowish hue and spoils the appearance of the stamp. It is also impossible to remove the stamp from a mount of this type.

Used decals are of necessity mounted in the above manner, but most collectors appear to handle the unused ones in the same manner although it is not as necessary. We have seen

pages of unused decals mounted on heavy ledger or bristol ring book pages by hinges as ordinary stamps and then the whole page enclosed in a transparent sheet protector. This serves the double purpose of keeping the stamps dry (a necessity in the case of decals) and protecting them from handling. This makes a very attractive mounting for any stamps which can be put on 8½ x 11 ring book pages.

There are also "heat seal" cigarette stamps which are much like decals in appearance and vulnerability to damage, and which must be protected in the same manner.

Still another type of cigarette tax stamp is the "pressure sensitive" kind which is much like the labels used on the packages in the super market. In unused condition they are found with a wax paper backing. They are pregummed in the same manner as scotch tape and are peeled from this waxed paper backing and placed on the package. The term "pressure sensitive" indicates that only a slight pressure is all that it takes to make them stick - no moistening of gum or use of heat or soaking like decals. In unused condition the wax paper backing does not work too well with hinges and in used condition they usually have cellophane adhering to the back, so should be handled in the same manner as decals. They are not likely to be damaged in the same manner by handling.

Meter impressions are also put into a mount, partly because hinges do not adhere properly, partly because they are usually on the end of the pack where the four sides are folded over and tend to come apart, and partly so that a piece of white paper can be put behind them to show up the design. One of those reporting how they mount these says he uses tinted backing to bring out the meter color. Another reports that he collects the values as well as the meter numbers. We might mention that sometimes there are a number of bars at one end of the meter beyond the design itself. We have been told that these indicate a new rate has been paid when a rate change is made and the meter value is not in money.

Paper stamps do not present any unusual problems except sometimes as to quality of paper, and quite often as to size of the stamp.

We have seen paper stamps put into mounts, one type with a white border around the stamp like a picture is sometimes mounted. Mostly, however, they are mounted with hinges, two or more being used on the larger stamps, sometimes at the top only, sometimes on each corner and also in the middle of the stamp as well.

Stamps that are too large for hinges can be fitted into photo mounts, on two corners or on all four, and transparent where they would cover the design of the stamp. Some collectors include in their collections such things as business license certificates and similar items. If the margin between the design and the edge of the paper is sufficient sometimes the photo corners can be colored, either black, white, or in a color to harmonize with the color of the stamp of certificate or cover. If it seems desirable, added protection can be had by placing a piece of heavy grade acetate the same size as

the stamp, over the stamp, securing it under the same photo corners which hold the stamp. If one includes complete sheets of stamps now and then in the collection, this seems to be the best way as it helps keep the stamps from sagging and slipping out of the mounts as the pages are turned. A few hinges applied at strategic points also helps.

This same method can be used in mounting documents bearing revenue stamps where only one side is to be visible, and they are small enough to be mounted on the album page. If both sides are to be seen, one of our readers cuts neat mat frames out of a light weight board, the same weight as he uses for meter and decals. The center cut out is somewhat smaller than the entire size of the document. Placing the document between the boards, he wraps the entire assembly in a kitchen commodity, the economical "Handy Wrap", securing with cellophane tape the edge that is inserted in the album. This provides a neat little "envelope" out of which both sides of the document can be viewed. This assembly can be punched easily (through the mat frame) and fitted into the album with a minimum of bulk.

One other method of mounting ones stamps is to use stock books with transparent pockets. We have heard of one such collection but have not seen it nor do we know the type of album used. It is the writers own experience that pages of this type with pockets on only one side of the page tend to bend and let the stamps slip out. He has had good luck in keeping duplicates in some of the bound books with transparent pockets on both sides of the page. This seems to equalize the tension and keep the pages from warping.

tags have to be handled very carefully, the older ones in particular, as they break if bent to any extent, so after being mounted they should be let alone. If it becomes necessary to remove them from the album page, it is best to remove the corner mounts from one end first so the tag may be slipped out without bending.

So much for the way of mounting the various kinds of stamps, etc. The albums themselves are to be considered next.

There seems to be no end to the different kinds and styles of albums: ring binders, spring back binders, post binders of various kinds. There are a multitude of sizes and kinds of pages.

Mr. Hermann, whose collection is among the largest, tells us that he uses 8½ x 11 plain heavy (36 pound) white album pages. These are made for ring binders and can be had in light bristol board or heavy ledger paper, both plain and quadrille ruled. It has been our observation that this is a rather popular type of album. This means, however, that the extra large stamps (the 8½ x 11 Georgia egg stamps for instance) must either be left unmounted or put in some type of album with oversize pages.

Mr. Caldwell has found that he has found his answer to the album problem by expanding his Scott's National Album into three volumes, with Federal revenues, Scott listed and unlisted, in the second volume and state revenues in the third volume. This leaves an opportunity for additional binders without having to reestablish his entire collection, as well as giving him opportunity to include separate small specialized collections.

For his Federal and U. S. possessions revenues he has used the blank matching-border pages made for the albums. For his state revenues he has used plain white 8½" x 11" 16 and 20 lb. duplicator stock punched to fit the binder. This volume is quite large, taking between 800 and 1,000 sheets, or around two 500 sheet reams, netting a nominal cost of about \$3.75.

U. S. STATE DOCUMENT STAMP CATALOG TO HONOR LEE COMBS JR.

For the stamps of his home state of Missouri, which required a great number of pages, he designed a suitable border and masthead incorporating the outline of the state in the center, with adequate lines and spaces on either side for the type of stamps, date, and other pertinent information to be typed in on each page. He cut this design onto a stencil, alternating colors, and printed the sufficient number of pages on a spirit type duplicator. The border and state outline and name are printed in blue and purple, and the information lines in red. Using a black typewriter he merely types in the necessary information, and, in the case of city tax stamps, with a red ball point pen indicates the location of the city within the state outline with a star.
