NEW U.S. LOCAL CIGARETTE STAMP DISCOVERIES AND ISSUES:

COLORADO (All decals unless mentioned otherwise):

AURORA VALUE IN LOWER CENTER HORIZONTAL OVAL: 1¢ green.

TORACCO LEAF DESIGN: 2¢ red.

COLORADO SPRINGS VALUE IN LOW CENTER OVAL: 1¢ red orange scotchcal.

DENVER LIKE 2¢ RED DECAL BUT SCOTCHCAL: 2¢ orange.

VALUE IN LOWER CORNERS: 2¢ rose scotchcal (hole between stamps).

GRAND JUNCTION VALUE IN CENTRAL COMPLETE CIRCIE ETC: 2¢ red.

LIMON, TOWN OF VALUE IN CENTRAL OVAL: 2¢ rose.

NUCIA VALUE IN LOWER CENTER CIRCLE: 3¢ green.

PONCHA SPRINGS VALUE IS CENTRAL FIGURE: Rouletted paper stamp: 2¢ orange red

PUEBLO VALUE IN LOW CENTER OVAL. Scotchcals: 1¢ black, 2¢ brown, 6¢ light blue, 8¢ yellow, 10¢ ??, 12¢ carmine.

SAGUACHE TOBACCO LEAF DESIGN: 2¢ red.

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS TOBACCO LEAF DESIGN: 2¢ red paper stamp.

VIOLET METER STAMPS ON CELLOPHANE (Unless noted differently)-

AURORA 1¢

BOULDER 20 cigs. (Mountain design)

DENVER 1¢

ENGLEWOOD 1¢

GRAND JUNCTION 2¢ purple

LA JUNTA 20 cigs.

PUEBLO 1¢

"REPLACEMENT METER" 20 cigs. (Evidently an emergency meter.)

WYOMING CHEYENNE 2¢ violet meter on cellophane.

U.S. WINE 1.60 4/5¢ VARIETIES:

STAMPS WITH SMALL LETTERS-

- I "4" base is above flag of "5" and second line is 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm long.
- II "4" base is even with flag of "5" and second line is 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm long.
- III Same as type II but second line is 25mm long.
- IV Same as type III but each figure of \$1.60 4/5 drops lower toward right.
- VI Small decimal and few, if any, serifs on spelled denomination. Figures appear thinner.
- VII "DOLLAR" error.
- VIII "DOILAR" error.
- V "4" base is below flag of "5" and second line is 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm long.

STAMPS WITH LARGE LETTERS:

- X Short "4" and "5" (2mm high) as in the stamps with the small letters.
- XI First line in large letters and second in small letters.
- XXI Tall "4" and "5" (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm tall).
