INVENTORIES OF UNUSED TAX STAMPS HELD BY DEALERS AND OUT-OF-STATE SUPPLIERS IS TO BE FILED. NO MENTION IS MADE OF FINAL DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS UNUSED STAMPS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE, OR WHETHER THEY WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO REVENUE STAMP ENTHUSIASTS.

THE MOTOR FUEL TAX DIVISION OF THE MISSOUR! DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE ISSUES TWO INSPECTION STAMPS ANNUALLY FOR EACH GASOLINE PUMP INSPECTED. THE 1964 STAMP, OF THE PRESSURE SENSITIVE DECAL TYPE, IS MULTICOLORED ORANGE, BLUE, BLACK AND WHITE, AND IS INSCRIBED "STATE OF MISSOURI/ DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE/ M. E. MORRIS, DIRECTOR/ THE MOTOR FUEL TAX DEPARTMENT/INSPECTED AND APPROVED THIS PUMP". THIS INSCRIPTION IS FOLLOWED BY A VALIDATING SPACE, THEN BY A SERIAL NUMBER AND THE YEAR 1964. THESE STAMPS ARE AFFIXED, A PAIR, TO EACH GASOLINE PUMP IN THE STATE, AND VERY FEW HAVE FALLEN INTO THE HANDS OF COLLECTORS, AS THEY ARE APPLIED TO THE PUMP AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION, AND CAN NOT BE REMOVED AFTER A REGULATION YEAR'S DISPLAY WITHOUT DESTRUCTION OR MUTILATION, AND THEN ARE USUALLY FADED AND DAMAGED BY THE ELEMENTS OF MISSOURI'S COLD WINTERS AND HOT SUMMERS.
