A MESSAGE FROM YOUR EDITOR -

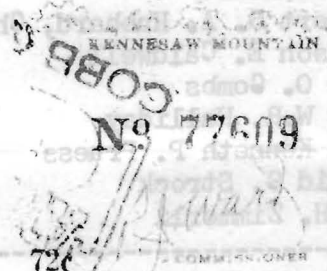

MISSISSIPPI TOBACCO TAX - Some new  
values for the 1964-65 paper stamps  
reported by Mr. Hermann are:

17¢ yellow green  
18¢ blue green (like 26¢)  
27¢ orange  
30¢ orange buff (instead of  
usual bright to deep orange)  
85¢ turquoise  
90¢ rose

Mr. Hermann says he has not seen  
all of the 1963 rates as 80¢ and  
84¢ nor the listed 25¢ in the  
current set. Do any of our readers  
have information on these?

Decals are frequently added to  
the paper stamps to make up the new  
rates. Illustrated is the 21¢ with  
two 3¢ decals to make 27¢ rate.  
Other combinations reported by Mr.  
Hermann are: 2¢ red decal on 15¢  
blue; 2 - 2¢ decals on 15¢; 1¢  
green decal on 16¢; 3¢ red orange  
decal on 27¢; 8¢ lilac decal on  
26¢. It is my opinion that these  
are made up by wholesalers to  
utilize existing stamp stocks.

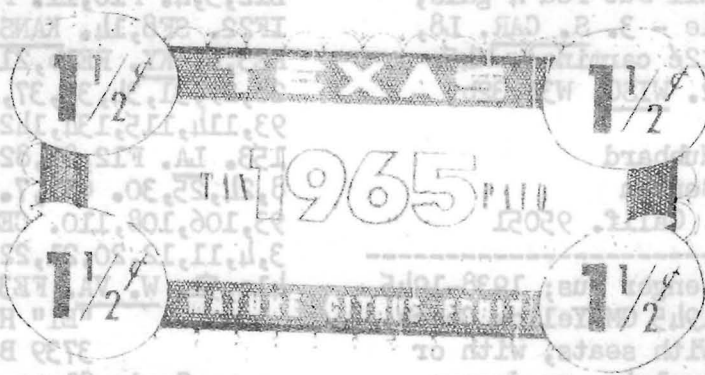




GEORGIA BEER TAX - Thanks to Mr. Hermann, we can present the following listing of 1/2 barrel stamps. The "X" numbers are not listed in Hubbard's catalog. X1 has not been seen. Does it exist without the overprint used to make X2? Who knows what other values go with these changes?

- B4 \$2.50 emerald green, 1 line (at bottom) "Georgia Laws 1935, pages 73-81 Amended March 30, 1937".
- B8 \$2.25 blue, 2 lines "Georgia Laws 1935, pages 73-81/ Amended March 30, 1937 and Dec. 13, 1937".
- X1 \$4.50 blue, 2 lines as B8 but "and July 29, 1949" added.
- X2 \$2.25 overprinted in red on X1, 3 groups of 3 -29 mm. lines over each \$4.50 and "\$2.25" below same.
- X3 \$2.25 blue, 3 lines "Georgia Laws 1935, pages 73-81/ as Amended February 20, 1951 Acts 1951/ pages 356 to 359 inclusive".
- X4 \$4.50 blue, 2 lines "Georgia Laws 1935, pages 73-81/ as Amended June 22, 1955 - Acts June 1955".
- X5 \$5.00 overprinted on X4 in red with 27 x 4 mm. bar over each \$4.50 and "\$5.00" below same.

TEXAS MATURE CITRUS FRUIT - Mr. Bloom shows us the 1965 stamp which is printed in orange on white paper. In addition to the stamp, Texas also uses a rubber stamp for the larger shippers who pack citrus on a volume basis. I regret the illustration submitted by Mr. Bloom has been lost. Perhaps we can show this in a future issue. This rubber stamp is in black ink, seal is shortened to 15 mm. to provide room for "JOHN C. WHITE. Comm. of Agric.", top and bottom panels solid, date and stamp number of different type.



MISSISSIPPI BEER - Mr. Hermann reports a beer stamp like Hubbard's BW 76 but double the rate. This is \$6.82 blue letter (B) like the \$3.41 and for the same 16 gal. keg.
