NEW HAMPSHIRE TOBACCO TAX - Terry Hines submits the following list of stamps in current use. All are decals. While some of these are the same design as past issues, there are many previously unreported denominations.

Small size ($10\frac{1}{2} \times 14$ mm), state seal design:

Large (24×24 mm), seal and numeral. All are green with black value (like last set listed in catalog). Those with asterisk are probably an older issue as they are not shown on the current list of available stamps. We include these since they are unlisted.

Other denominations listed on requisition form but not seen by Mr. Hines are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ (C34 ?) and 11¢.

Meters: $4\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ blue, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ red purple, 7¢ light blue, 7¢ green.

NEW YORK COMBINATION STATE-CITY CIGARETTE TAX STAMP

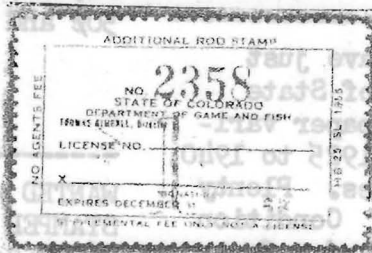
While it is an old issue, your editor thinks this little brown decal is a most unusual tax. The value on the left is the 2¢ state tax; the 1¢ city tax is shown on the right. Does anyone know of other examples? Combination meters are common.



COLORADO

Additional Rod Stamps

Entitles purchaser to fish with an extra rod in certain designated areas.



1955-65 \$1.00 black on white, red serial number and value. Printed text, blank for rubber stamped year date. Perf 12 $\frac{1}{2}$. Overall size 46 x 30 mm. From sheets of 50 (5 x 10) s.e. all four sides.



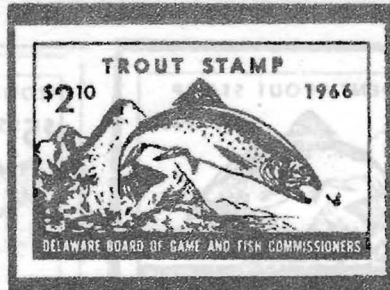
1966 \$1.00 blue on white, red serial number, printed date. Perf 12 $\frac{1}{2}$. Design is mountain goat ram's head insignia of the Colo. Game, Fish and Parks Comm. Overall size 40 x 26 mm. Text changed to read "Second Rod Stamp". From vertical booklet panes of 5, perforated selvage all four sides. Pane size is 77 x 166 mm.



1967 \$1.00 green on white, printed date. All detail, pane size, etc. same as 1966 stamp except size of insignia has been reduced, serial number in green. Selvage at left is imprinted "Accountable Value \$.75" opposite each stamp.

DELAWARETrout Fishing Stamps

- 1956 through 1964 issues from panes of four, straight edge all four sides, perf 12 between. $44 \times 28\frac{1}{2}$ mm (design size). Pictures a leaping trout with mountains in the background (very similar to New Jersey Trout Stamps). "Resident Trout Stamp" at top inside frame (first year only - balance "Trout Stamp"), value at left, date at right, and "Delaware Board of Game and Fish Commissioners" at bottom.
- 1956 \$2.10 Resident. Black on light blue, unsurfaced paper.
 \$5.25 Non-resident. Black on blue, unsurfaced paper. (Law authorizing \$5.25 non-resident stamp was never put into effect. None was ever required for fishing. At least one imperforate copy, possibly a proof, exists). Design same as resident except for face value and "Non-Resident Trout Stamp" at top.
- 1957 \$2.10 blue on yellow surfaced paper. All other detail same as 1956 except "Resident" deleted.
- 1958 \$2.10 red on white, unsurfaced paper. Otherwise like 1957.
- 1959 \$2.10 black on blue, unsurfaced paper. Otherwise like 1957.
- 1960 \$2.10 black on buff, unsurfaced paper. Otherwise like 1957.
- 1961 \$2.10 black on bright green surfaced paper, other detail same as 1957.
- 1962 \$2.10 red on white unsurfaced paper, other detail same as 1957.
- 1963 \$2.10 blue green on white unsurfaced paper, other detail same as 1957.
- 1964 \$2.10 orange red on white unsurfaced paper, other detail same as 1957.
- 1965 \$2.10 black on white unsurfaced paper, roul $9\frac{1}{2}$ (pane size unknown), other detail same as 1957.

Trout Fishing Stamps

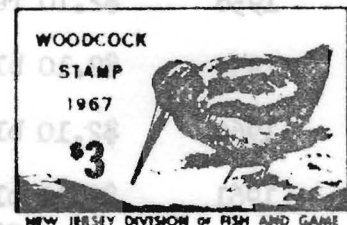
1966 \$2.10 black on yellow unsurfaced paper, design same as 1957. Panes were cut into single stamps and gummed at top edges by the printer to form pads of stamps. Examples seen by the writer are all roul 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ at either right or left side and imperf other three sides.

1967 \$2.10 black on blue surfaced paper, design same as 1957. Gummed at top to form pads as in 1966. However, only stamp seen by the writer was imperf at top and right and roul 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ at bottom and left suggesting the possibility these stamps may have been manually separated prior to gumming into pads.

NEW FISH AND GAME ISSUES -

Tennessee - \$1 Archery hunting stamp valid 7/1/67 to 6/30/68. The design is a running buck deer, bull's eye target and outline map of Tennessee all superimposed on large arrowhead.

New Jersey - Although the 1960 and 1961 New Hampshire combination hunting and fishing stamps included a woodcock as part of the design, New Jersey is the first to issue a stamp specifically for woodcock hunting. The \$3.00 stamp, brown on yellow, depicting a woodcock was required for the "early season" ending 11/9/67. The stamp is perf 12, overall size 50 x 31 mm. Our thanks to Mr. Effner for the illustration. Lee Bookler tells us that remainders will be sold to collectors 5 years from now, as is done with trout stamps. Speaking of trout stamps, a completely new design is now in use on the New Jersey issues. We regret the photocopy shown us by Mr. Effner would not produce a satisfactory illustration.



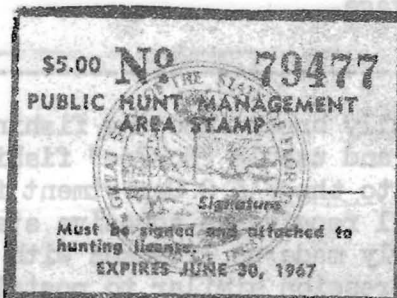
New York - A \$3.25 Archery Hunting stamp was issued for 1967.

FLORIDA

Public Hunting Area Stamps

All sizes listed below are "overall". Sizes listed for 1951-52 and 1952-53 are approximate as great variation exists in both issues.

1951-52 \$5.00 to hunt Deer and Turkey. 51 x 35 mm, black printing on white paper, 25 mm (round) seal of Florida in green at center. Red serial number. Rouletted approximately 6 3/4. (9708 sold)



1952-53 \$5.00 - same purpose. 53 x 40 mm, black printing on white paper, 25 mm seal of Florida in pink. Dark green serial number. Rouletted 6 1/2. (12,975 sold)

1951-52 stamps are believed to have been printed in the same format as the 1952-53 stamps but at this time only three copies are known to this writer and a positive statement cannot be made.

1952-53 stamps were from sheets of nine - straight edge at top, right and bottom. Selvage of approximately 19 mm at left. Overall sheet size approximately 184 x 105 mm. Rouletted 6 1/2 between all stamps and between stamps and selvage.

Stamps discontinued after season of 1952-53 and space provided on hunting licenses to show collection of fee until season of 1966-67 when issue of stamps was resumed.

Public Hunting Area Stamps

- 1966-67 \$5.00 black printed text on green paper. Great seal of Florida in faint gray. Roul 4 3/4, red serial number. Overall size 51 x 37 mm. From sheets of unknown size.



- 1967-68 \$5.00 black on pink. Flushing covey of bobwhite quail and forest scene. Red serial number. Overall size 52 x 37 mm. From vertical booklet panes (1 x 5) roul 4 3/4 horizontally between stamps and 6 1/4 vertically at left selvage.

CALIFORNIA - Meters finally break into the fishing and hunting stamp field!

Although clean and usable "No Fee" fishing licenses from prior years returned to the F & G Department for validation for 1968 usage will still receive an adhesive stamp, the Department plans to validate newly made up licenses with a Tickometer which produces an impression similar to postal metering machines.

NEW JERSEY CIGARETTE - Mr. Effner reports that the stamp illustrated in the September issue was sold out during 1966. The current stamp is a black decal on cream safety card, black roul 6 1/2 between panes. This was issued Nov. 17, 1966. While no monetary value is shown on the stamp, it represents a tax of 11¢.



WEST VIRGINIA SOFT DRINKS - The 2¢ stamp for 32 oz or less (SD2) is reported by Mr. Lichtenberger with pressure sensitive gum. He found this on a quart of chocolate milk. Have other soft drink tax stamps been used on milk?

OHIO CIGARETTE - Glenn Compton shows us the new 7¢ heat transfer decal. This is black on gray green surrounded by a yellow border. The usual 9 x 9 mm size with red safety. We regret that the colors would not permit a usable illustration.

REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAXES - We have had reports from only a few members. This tax went into effect in many states on Jan. 1. Quite a few states will apparently use rubber hand stamps or meters rather than adhesive stamps. Whatever the case, we would appreciate a report and, if possible, a sample copy even of the hand stamps.
